

### The Art of the Heel




My original high heel design was created for a Jimmy Choo Sketch Competition. The shoe features an exaggerated, collectible heel — layered with stacked geometric shapes, including a layered yellow and light blue orb, textured rings, and a faceted base. The toe is adorned with crystal—like formations, while the back strap fans into a pleated sculptural flourish topped with violet cubes. Hand—drawn with colored pencil and marker on paper, the design merges elegance with imaginative, almost architectural play.




Image 2: Initial silhouette + pose exploration


Image 3: Refining color + structure

#### Project Overview

Treeman asked me to develop illustrated concepts and product naming directions for the launch of their first collection. I created custom fashion illustrations, explored design personalities, and proposed naming ideas that aligned with the brand's aesthetic and audience.
